Two things are needed:

- 2. Volunteers to bring a few pies for dessert.

Together we will "Celebrate God's Goodness", share faith stories, and consider a larger vision of what God is doing in our lives, and through Christ Lutheran.

Strategic Mission Planning

- 1. Focus on a concrete step each month, and then evaluate our progress.
- 2. Focus on what is most important, not just what is most urgent.
- 3. Instead of putting out little fires, or focusing an inordinate amount of time and energy on agenda items like "property and maintenance" we will be following through on God's mission for CLC.

Mission planning challenges

- 1. Feeling too comfortable with the status quo not sensing God's urgency for those in our mission field (the CLC neighborhood, and all our unchurched neighbors, friends, and relatives).
- a. Do we have a future beyond 5 or 10 years without more intentional witness and outreach?
- b. Will each member commit to praying our "outreach prayer" (at the top of the Prayer List) and ask God to direct our steps?
- c. How can we encourage prayer and action... and share stories to encourage one another?
- 2. Committing an inordinate amount of time, energy, and financial resources on property and maintenance
- 3. The time required nurturing relationships with CLC CC, PdP, and Troop 531.
