On October 31, 1517, Martin Luther posted 95 Theses on the chapel door of Wittenberg College in protest of Pope Leo X's intention to sell indulgences to help build St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Luther saw this as corrupting people's faith, and he knew he had to act. The ELCA commemorates this event every year on the Sunday nearest this date as a festival Sunday with red paraments. Members are also encouraged to wear red.

Special music will include a Cello performance by Diana Parmeter, Tom's sister, and a special choir that will include Larry and Lorrie Klevos, Annemarie Randle-Trejo and CLC singers. Rehearsal for the choir is this Sunday at noon. All interested singers are invited to rehearse.
