Council Votes to Contribute to Bishop's Fund

The offering taken during the worship services at the Synod Assembly are always designated for a specific ministry. This year the funds will be directed to honor the first two bishops of the Pacifica Synod, Robert Miller and Murray Finck: the new Murray and Rhoda Finck Global Engagement Mission (GEM) and the ongoing Robert L. Miller Scholarship Fund. The council authorized donating \$250 from the general fund to GEM to honor Bishop Finck's 18 years of service. In addition, the council will provide the opportunity for the congregation to contribute to one or both of the funds through a special offering on May 1.
