SYNOD ASSEMBLY SCHEDULED

The Annual Pacifica Synod Assembly will be held Thursday-Saturday, May 5-7, at the Irvine Marriott Hotel. CLC is allowed two delegates, preferably one male and one female. Registration usually begins late February or early March, so delegates will be needed soon. Election of a new bishop for the next 6 years will be uppermost on the agenda. Delegates will have an important role in choosing the right person.

Pastor Keith and the council believe there is value in the statement: YOU ARE AGREEING TO RADICAL CHANGES IN ORDER TO BEAR FRUIT IN MINISTRY IN THE PRESENT AND FUTURE.
